They have provided baskets filled with essentials and gifts to over 50 women exiting incarceration from MCCC. However, WPM has decided to discontinue baskets and turn over the "gifting program" to the local multi-organizational group, Maui Coming Home (MEO, Kaahumanu Church, WHW, etc., to name a few), in order to concentrate on the night visits. Three baskets are waiting to be presented to three special women scheduled to be released sometime this year who have faithfully attended the night classes. WPM wishes to thank each and everyone of St. Anthony Church, for the donations and kind encouragements. Hiedi and Monica will no longer collect donations but could always use your continued encouraging words and prayers for the ongoing Tuesday classes.
