**LIVING CATHOLIC IN THE 808

Today's Gospel seems so far removed from our typical Catholic life. However, most of us are actually quite like the disciples who took nothing for the journey. How? It might be to not only give the homeless woman a gift card, but to also say that you do this because Jesus is good to you and so you want to be good to her.

This week, I "double dog dare" you! Trust Jesus – pray that he send you out into an evangelization situation you can handle.
